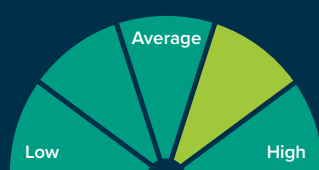

Expected job openings

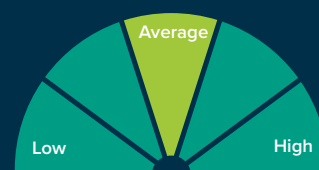
177,200 workers were employed as Aged and Disabled Care Workers in 2019. Job openings over the next 5 year is expected to be around 222,300.*
