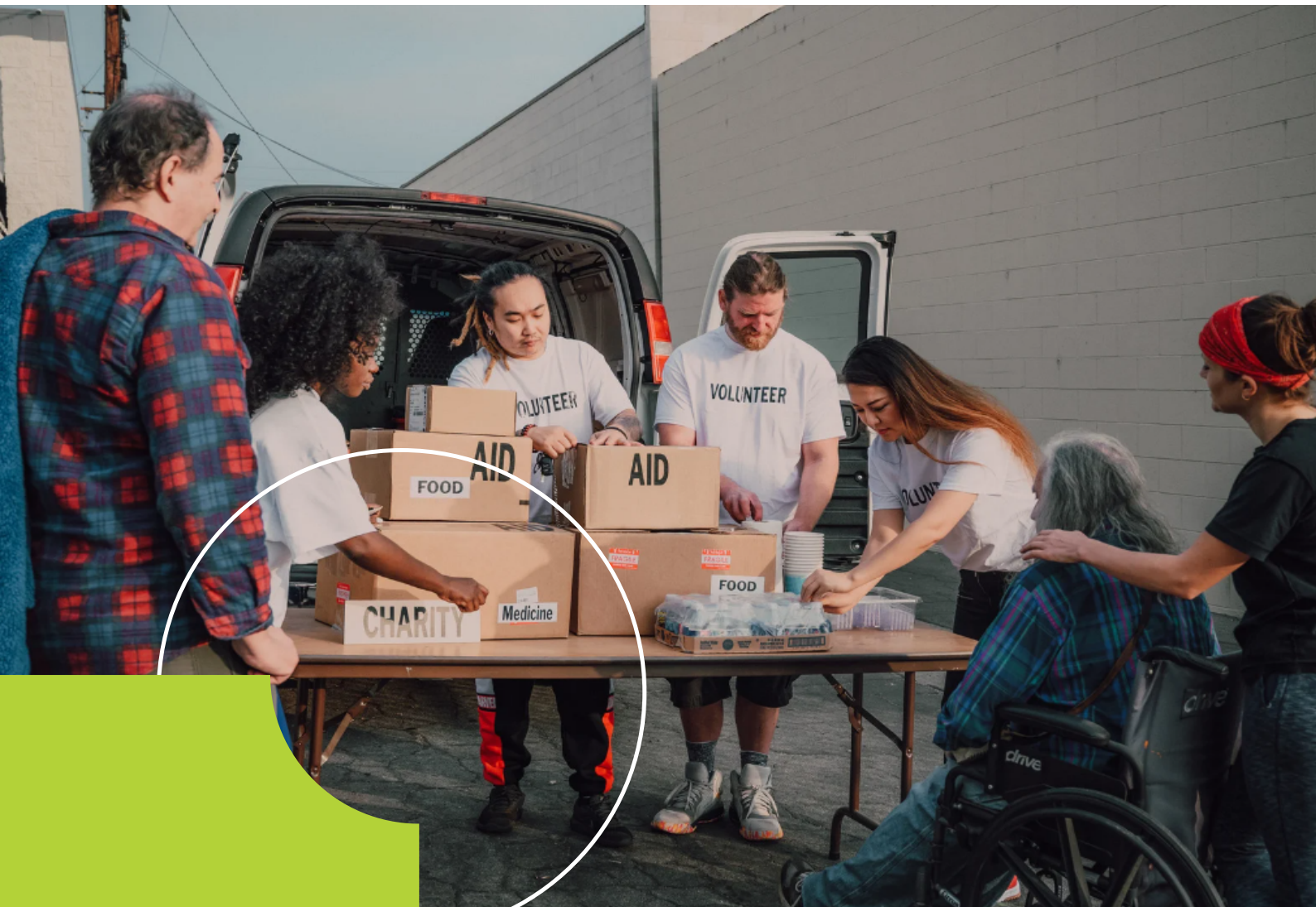

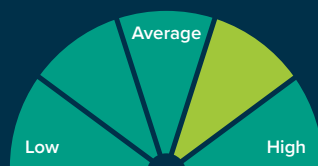

Expected job openings

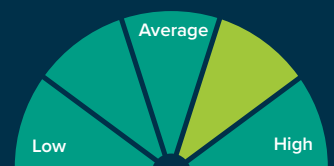
The Community Services industry is expected to grow by up to 94,700 workers by 2026 equating to a future growth of 25.2%.
