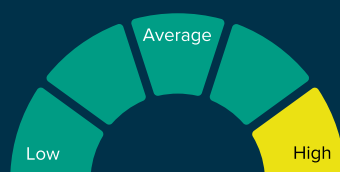

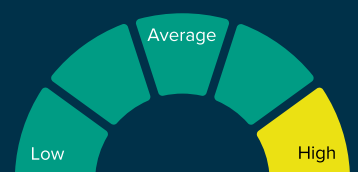
Expected job openings
