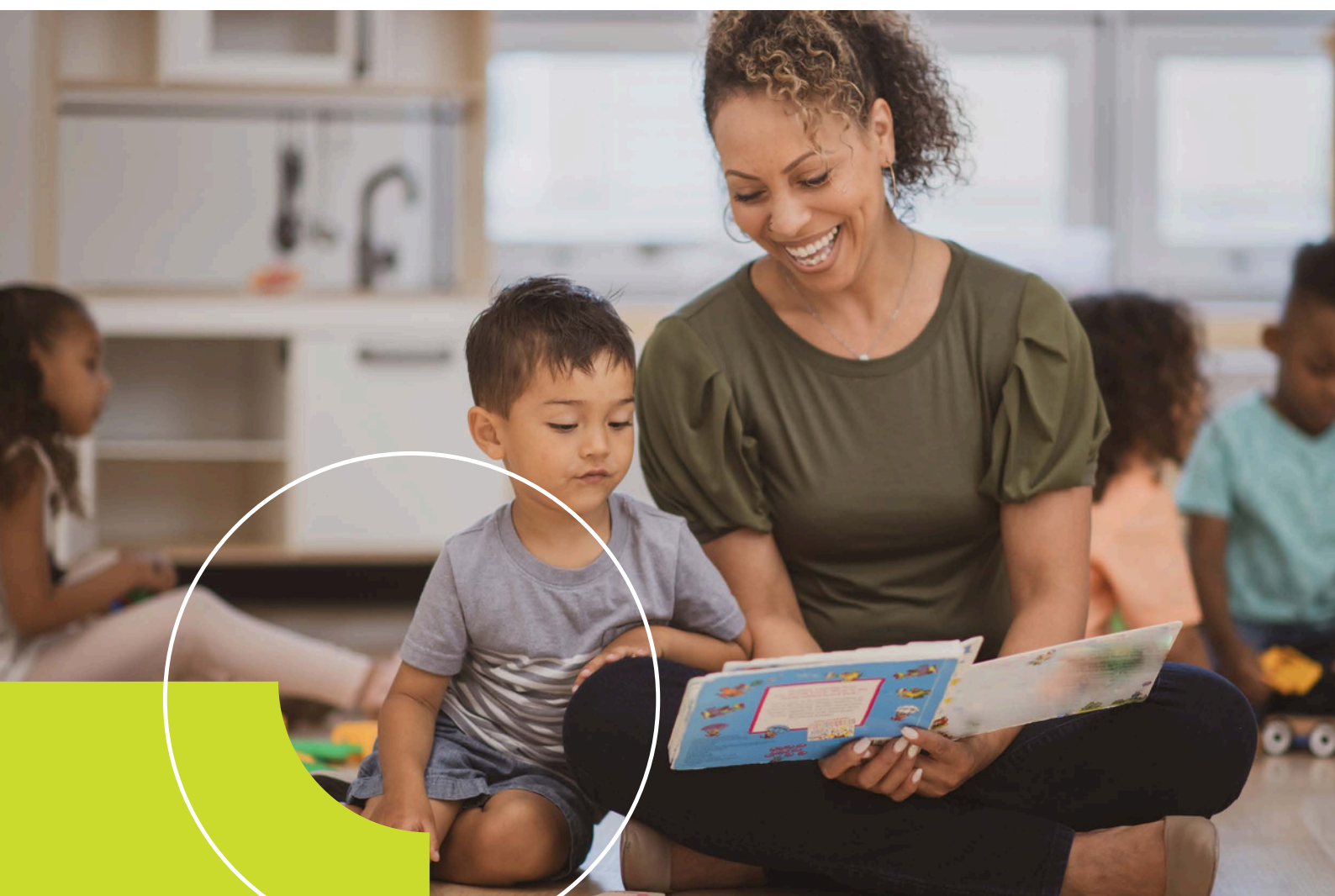



CHC30125 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care

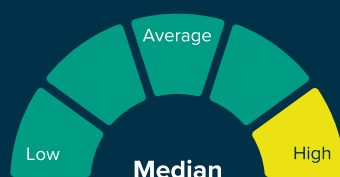

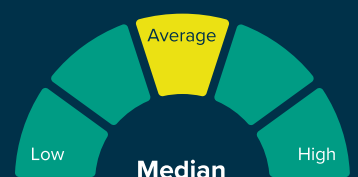
Expected job openings
